

## The 1867 Society

For one hundred and forty years, Barber-Scotia College has been a productive entity in Concord and the surrounding communities. Throughout its long history of existence, this institution has offered opportunities to students who might not have otherwise received a college education. In spite of many challenges the Alumni are determined not to allow this institution to go out of existence. Donations from faithful and loyal graduates, along with churches and businesses, have allowed the college to remain open in a limited fashion.

To provide an annual fundraising mechanism for Barber-Scotia College the **1867 Society** was established. The **1867 Society** also provides a vehicle for recognition of those persons who generously and regularly give financial support by inducting them as members in the **Society**. The “**1867 Society**” is derived from the year Scotia was established as Scotia Seminary.

On April 28, 2006 forty-two members of the Barber-Scotia College family were inducted as charter members of the **1867 Society**. On April 28, 2007 another fourteen members were inducted. Our next class of inductees will join the **Society** on April 28, 2008 during the celebration of our 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Spring Gala.

All funds contributed in support of the **Society** will be used for much needed operating capital at the College. Membership in the **Society** will also require a sustaining fee of \$186.70 beginning the year following your induction.

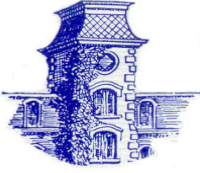
